<u>Policies & Guidelines</u>: This is NOT a regular meeting of Narcotics Anonymous but is a special function with special requirements to operate successfully and safely.

<u>Note:</u> Any reference to the Spring Clean #39 Committee will be read as "the committee". Any reference to Camp Potlatch will be read as "the camp".

- 1. The only requirement to attend this event is a desire to stay clean. However, for the safety of all attending **no-one may attend with drugs or paraphernalia on their person.** This camp policy will be enforced for all attending. Anyone found using or with drugs or paraphernalia will be asked to leave at their own expense. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 2. Cabin assignment requests will be addressed on a "first paid first served" basis. The committee will not be responsible if they are unable to fulfill specific requirements.
 - a. Cabin assignments can be changed as long as the "destination" of the cabin is not changed. A women's cabin must remain a women's cabin, **unless agreed upon by all guests assigned to that cabin.**
- 3. Any personal article brought to the camp will be the owner's full responsibility. Neither the camp nor the committee will be responsible for loss or damage to personal articles.
- 4. Candles and any other open flames are prohibited indoors. Smoking and campfires will be permitted in authorized areas only.
- 5. There will be **NO** gambling, pets, hatchets or knives permitted during this event.
- Children are to be supervised by an authorized adult AT ALL TIMES. The committee
 members (or other campers) are not babysitters. There is a Child Care Coordinator on
 the committee.
- 7. The operators and staff of the camp will be treated with the utmost respect they are our hosts. What the camp has to say with regard to camp operations will be treated as **LAW!**
- 8. Anyone leaving the camp for any reason (including hiking) must sign in & out. There will be full head counts at dinner.
- 9. PAYMENT MUST BE MADE IN FULL PRIOR TO TRAVEL NO partial or scheduled payments
- 10. NO REFUNDS REGARDLESS OF REASON.

NOTE: The costs of camp has risen dramatically and continue to rise. Through our fundraising efforts, Spring Clean is able to subsidize the cost of registration for those who need assistance. Any donation to the financial assistance fund is greatly appreciated!!


